Shootouts are two ends without opponents, second end is double score.

Shootout rules

Throw in normal throwing order (lead throws 1 & 2, second throws 3 & 4, etc.) with sweeping as in a normal game. No opponent sweeping.

Do not remove stones in play (pulling them from play. Takeouts are allowed.) There is no free-guard zone rule.

After all eight stones have been thrown, count how many stones are touching the 12-foot ring, the 8-foot ring, etc.

For close calls, an official will make a decision.

Record first-end results on the Score Card

Remove stones. Repeat coming home for second end.
